The Bartley Print Center has merged operations with Graphic Services and relocated to Aldwyn One at the conclusion of the Fall 2023 semester. After the move Print Center services will be offered in Aldwyn One on Lancaster Avenue (building 75 on the Campus Map). In this new location, the Print Center will resume normal operations and accept IPRINT and walk-up job submissions for faculty, staff, and students.

UPDATE: For the next 2 weeks student iPRINT jobs will be delivered to the bins twice a day at Bartley. please allow plenty of time to have your jobs printed and delivered. We appreciate your patience.

Mailroom: Also in January 2024, the mailroom will be relocating from Kennedy Hall to Aldwyn One on Lancaster Avenue (building 75 on the <u>Campus Map</u>). Mail Services will continue to serve as central receiving for the university and the move will not impact on-campus delivery services or campus mail. Student package services will not be changed or impacted by this move. After the move, outbound mail and packages can be given to your daily mail carrier or dropped off to Aldwyn One.
